



#### Dear Parents,

Thank you to everyone who completed the parent questionnaire. We received 17 responses in total, which is great!


Please find below the results of the questionnaire with a commentary underneath them.




Every year group is represented which is great.




We are delighted that the majority of children are happy to come to our school. For children who are unhappy attending school please talk to us and we will do what we can to help.




We are delighted that the majority of children feel safe while they are with us. If your child feels unsafe please talk to us. Our safeguarding governor also asks the children if they feel safe at school.

We take bullying seriously and are pleased that the majority of parents feel any incidents of bullying are dealt with quickly and effectively.








We have several times during the year when you can find out how well your child is doing, -


- Parents' Evening in the Autumn Term

In addition to these our staff are always available if you would like to arrange a time to discuss how well your child is doing.






Due to our small size it is difficult for us to offer a variety of clubs and activities as numbers attending these would be small.
