



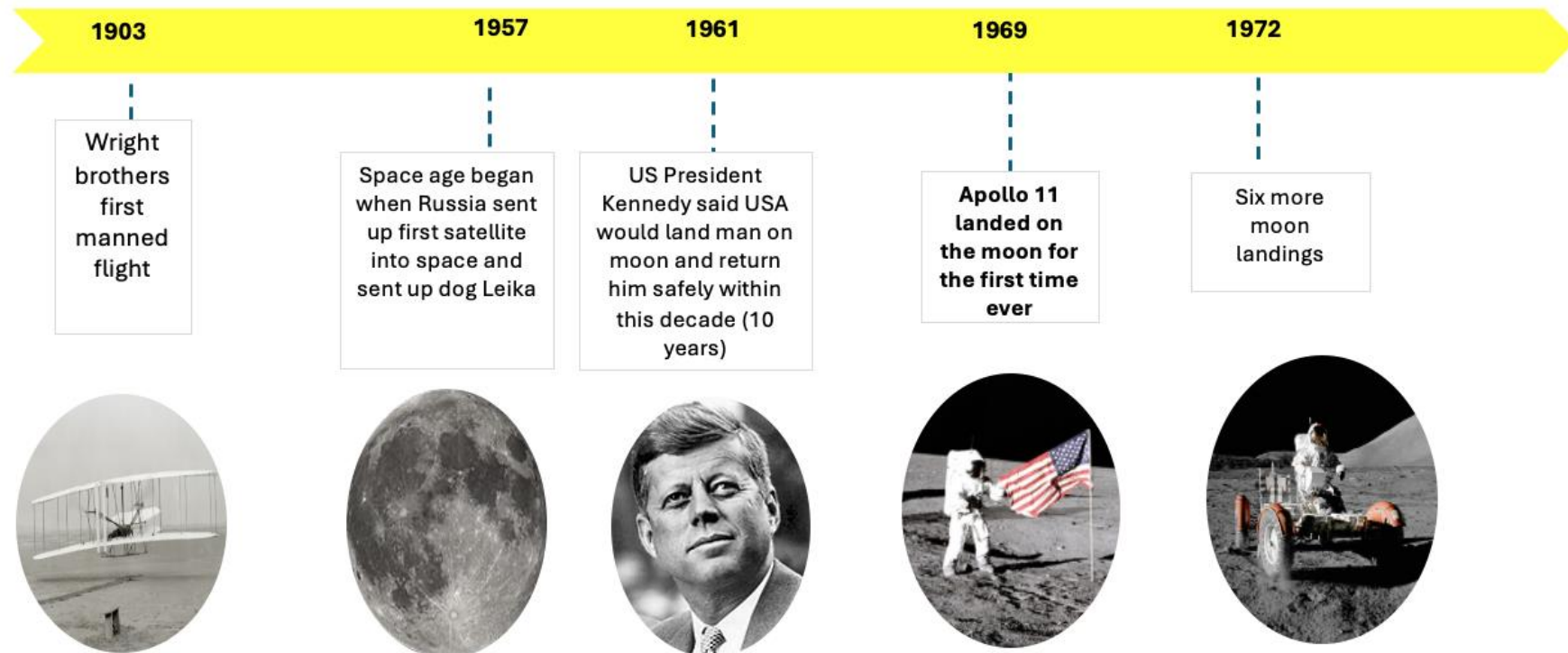

Key Vocabulary

Wright brothers	Two brothers, Orville Wright and Wilbur Wright, who built and flew the first successful aeroplane.
Inventor	A person who creates something new.
First flight	The very first-time something flies, like when the Wright brothers' plane went into the air.
Chronological	Putting things in the order they happened (from first to last).
Aeroplane	A machine with wings that flies in the sky.
Powered flight	Flying using an engine (not just gliding).
Impact	The effect something has or the change it makes.
Source of evidence	Something that helps us learn about the past, like pictures, books, or objects.
Significant	Important or special.
Astronauts	People who travel and work in space.
Space exploration	Learning about space by sending people or machines there.
Mission	A special job or task, like a trip into space.
Motivation	The reason why someone wants to do something.
Reasons	Why something happens or why someone does something.
