Weekly Spelling List Sequence



WK 1. Provide pupils with a small selection of words to learn either from the common exception words for Year 2 (page 79), words that pupils are commonly spelling incorrectly, or words containing GPCs that you have looked at in previous sessions. Pupils practise using segmentation strategy to learn the words.

- WK 2. Homophones
- WK 3. Spelling Rules: The /j/ sound spelled with a g.
- WK 4. Spelling Rules: The suffixes '-ment' and '-ness'
- WK 5. Spelling Rules: Adding '-er' to words ending in y. The y is changed to an i.
- WK 6. Spelling Rules: The /n/ sound spelled kn and gn at the beginning of words.
- WK 7. Spelling Rules: The /s/ sound spelled c before e, i and y.
- WK 8. Spelling Rules: The /r/ sound spelled 'wr' at the beginning of words.
- WK 9. Spelling Rules: Adding '-es' to nouns and verbs ending in 'y.'
- WK 10. Spelling Rules: The /j/ sound spelled -dge at the end of words. This spelling is used after the short vowel sounds.
- WK 11. Spelling Rules: The /l/ or /ul/ sound spelled '-le' at the end of words.
- WK 12. Spelling Rules: The /I/ or /uI/ sound spelled '-el' at the end of words. This spelling is used after m,
- n, r, s, v, w and commonly s.
- WK 13. Spelling Rules: The /l/ or /ul/ sound spelled '-al' at the end of words.
- WK 14. Spelling Rules: Words ending in '-il.'
- WK 15. Spelling Rules: The long vowel 'i' spelled with a y at the end of words.
- WK 16. Spelling Rules: Adding '-ed' to words ending in y. The y is changed to an i.
- WK 17. Spelling Rules: Adding 'ing' to words ending in 'e' with a consonant before it.
- WK 18. Spelling Rules: Adding 'er' to words ending in 'e' with a consonant before it.
- WK 19. Spelling Rules: Adding '-ing' to words of one syllable. The last letter is doubled to keep the short vowel sound.
- WK 20. Spelling Rules: Adding '-ed'' to words of one syllable. The last letter is doubled to keep the short

vowel sound.

- WK 21. Spelling Rules: The 'or' sound spelled 'a' before II and II
- WK 22. Spelling Rules: The short vowel sound 'o.'

- WK 23. Spelling Rules: The /ee/ sound spelled '-ey'
- WK 24. Spelling Rules: Words with the spelling 'a' after w and qu.
- WK 25. Spelling Rules: The /er/ sound spelled with o or ar.
- WK 26. Spelling Rules: The /z/ sound spelled s.
- WK 27. Spelling Rules: The suffixes '-ful' and '-less' If a suffix starts with a consonant letter. It is added straight onto most root words.
- WK 28. Spelling Rules: These words are homophones or near homophones. They have the same pronunciation but different spellings and/or meanings
- WK 29. Spelling Rules: These words are homophones or near homophones. They have the same pronunciation but different spellings and/or meanings.
- WK 30. Spelling Rules: Words ending in '-tion.'
- WK 31. Spelling Rules: Contractions the apostrophe shows where a letter or letters would be if the words were written in full.
