


Design and Technology: Year 2 - Spring Term - Mechanisms - Sliders and Levers

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Vocabulary	
design	A plan or idea of what the product will be like and how it will function.
design criteria	The rules or important things to think about when making something.
evaluate	I can talk about what is good about a product and ways it can be improved.
investigating	Looking carefully to find out or learn something new.
lever	A bar or stick that helps lift or move something by pushing or pulling.
make	Creating or building something using tools and materials.
pivot	A point where something turns or moves, like a hinge.
planning	Thinking about something before doing it
pull	When you use your hands or body to bring something closer to you.
push	When you use your hands or body to move something away from you.
slider	A part of something that moves back and forth in a straight line.
split pin	A little metal pin that holds things together and can open at the ends like legs.
user	Someone who uses or plays with something, like a person who plays with a toy or works on a computer.
