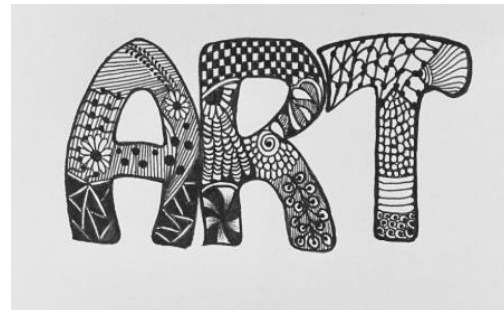

Key Vocabulary	Definition
compare	To note or describe the similarities or differences of something
primary colour	Any one of the three basic colours of the spectrum from which all other colours can be made by blending. In paint, they are red, yellow, and blue.
secondary colour	A colour resulting from the mixing of two primary colours.
shades	Where an artist adds black to a colour to darken it down
tints	Where an artist adds a colour to white to create a lighter version of the colour
cityscape	A picture of a city
landscape	A picture of an area of the countryside
line	A long, thin mark on the surface of something
space	The distances or areas around, between, and within components of a piece
perspective	A way of showing objects on the flat surface of a picture so that they seem the correct size and distance from one another.
background	Area behind and around the main subjects (pictures).
detail	A detail is a small bit or part of something.
matchstick figures	A matchstick figure is a simple drawing of a person using thin lines for the arms and legs, and a circle for the head.
collage	A collage is a piece of art made from different pieces of paper, photos and other materials.
